## Notes:

measurements: 34 x 175 centimeters after blocking

needles: US size 8 (5.0 mm european size)

yarn: 2 balls (= 50 gramm) of "mohair luxe" by lang yarns (approx. 190 yard = 25 gramm = 175 meters)

Cast on 43 sts

First row at wrongside: purl

Start knitting with chart, row 1 (odd rows are always rightside)

Wrongside: always purl (so shown in chart)

Repeat the marked 6-sts-repeat for a total of 6 times (only once is shown in chart) to get the width; repeat row 1 – 4 (remember row 4 is a wrongside row, not shown in chart!) until you get the desired length (row 5 – 15 is only shown for better understanding).

***You hate charts and want to have a written pattern and want to make the stole wider? I'll try to explain (in germany we only work with charts...):***

The pattern includes a 6-stitch-repeat over 4 rows. All wrongside rows are purled.

Row 1 (rightside row):

k2 [k3, yo, slip1-k2tog-pass slipped stitch over k2tog, yo] [ x times → repeat sts in brackets as often you want] k5

Row2 (wrongside row): purl

Row 3 (rightside row):

k2 [yo, slip1-k2tog-pass slipped stitch over k2tog, yo, k3] [ x times → repeat sts in brackets as often you want] yo, slip1-k2tog-pass slipped stitch over k2tog, yo, k2

Row 4 (wrongside row): purl

→ repeat always row 1 - 4

***Important: the stitches, which are shown in the brackets [ ...] are the stitch repeat. Repeat this stitches as often you want to widen your stole. Please note, that the amount of repeats in row 1 and 3 have to be identical.***

**That means:**

Always start row 1 (as written above) with k2 ... and end with k5.

Always start row 3 (as written above) with k2 ... and end with yo, slip1-k2tog-pass slipped stitch over k2tog, yo, k2

I repeated the stitches in brackets 6 times  $\rightarrow 6 \times 6 = 36 + 2$  (sts beginning of row1) + 5 (sts at end of row) = 43 sts total

To get the get you desired stitch number you have to decide how often you want to repeat the 6-sts-repeat  $\rightarrow 6 \times$  (amount of repeats) + 2 + 5 = total cast on sts.
